All data from the detection sites is transmitted via General Packet Radio Services (GPRS), in combination with data from the BluetoothTM, to our operational partner Drakewell's C2 Web, a software

solution that delivers accurate traffic data that is easily sharable via a web browser. This data is critical in monitoring and managing network performance in the TfGM control room, providing access to numerous statistical and real-time reports on their network.

This term commission includes the installation of new equipment and repairs to existing traffic monitoring sites. Q-Free's Engineering Services team coordinates work as approved by TfGM via liaison with regional authorities in, and around Manchester, Derbyshire and Derby City.
